Status of Pendency/disposal of cases between 1.4.2014 to 31.3.2015 in the State Offices of NCSC and Hqrs.

Decision Taken: (i) After analysis of data the Commission decided that the Member should visit the State Offices to dispose of cases concerning their allotted States.

- (ii) A plan may be chalked out for disposal of old cases in the next six months at Headquarter and State Offices and files after scrutiny may be submitted before the concerned Members for decision.
- (iii) For Atrocity cases- Members will conduct district wise/division wise reviews which will help in speedy action by authorities.
- (iv) Cases once closed can be re-opened only with the prior approval of the Hon'ble Chairman on file.
- (v) All efforts will be made for speedy disposal and as far as possible a maximum of 3 hearings to be conducted in cases. (Action: SSW/APCR/ESDW & State Offices)
- (vi) The visit to States should be evenly distributed which at present are skewed too much toward the home state.
